Job Description:

Reporting to the Maintenance Supervisor, the Ticketed Millwright/Apprentice position is a key member of the Maintenance team. Working with other trades, the position will be required to work safely and productively with minimum supervision and will be tasked to help maintain site facilities including, stationary, mobile, and ship loading equipment.

This position requires a demonstrated ability to assist in the identification and early detection requirements of preventative maintenance. The Ticketed Millwright/Apprentice is required to repair or replace defective machinery parts, fabricate parts, detect and troubleshoot irregularities and malfunctions, assemble and install machinery and equipment, operate hoisting and lifting equipment, and perform routine maintenance on equipment throughout the site.

Previous leadership experience or willingness to learn and take on a leadership role will be considered a strong asset.

- Demonstrated familiarity and compliance with all relevant safety policies and regulations
- Red Seal certification as a Millwright or 3rd or 4th year Apprenticeship documentation (Orca will sponsor the apprenticeship for completion)
